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

What a feeling!



Love and Perfection


What is evoked by perfection

Walk into the beautifully arrayed mountain store pull out a dollar pockets of success smooth it out exchange a colorfully laminated ticket for the carousel of happiness


Wait in line for your turn to pick the wise panda hand carved by a solder returned from the Vietnam war imbuing the wood healing the scars of conflict

All I have is


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
